**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
between
Aarhus University Denmark
and
Universitas Diponegoro Indonesia**

1. Purpose of this document

This Memorandum of Understanding outlines the relative intentions of Aarhus University, Denmark and Universitas Diponegoro, Indonesia to develop links under the principles of mutual understanding, mutual benefits, common interest, shared goals and mutually complementary activities.

2. Objectives

- 2.1. Each institution pledges to co-operate in a spirit of mutual understanding and to develop a closer relationship of goodwill and friendship.
- 2.2. Each institution will share information with the other to help promote mutual understanding, and each will respect the confidentiality and intellectual ownership of this information.
- 2.3. On the basis of close co-operation, each institution will undertake work towards the facilitation of joint education projects and other agreed upon scholarly activities which may include, but are not limited to:
 - Collaborative research and supervision of higher degree candidates
 - Collaborative applications for grants and funding
 - Collaborative and joint delivery of award programs
 - Collaborative and joint delivery of Continuing Professional Development (CPD)
 - Consultancy work
 - Qualification recognition and articulation arrangements
 - Study tours and summer schools
 - Student & staff exchange
 - Fee-paying Study Abroad (term or year-long)
 - Joint seminar
- 2.4. Each university will respect the name and high reputation of the other, and will consult with the other regarding any publicity or external reference to this MOU.

3. Period of Arrangement

- 3.1. This MOU shall commence on the date of its execution by the last to sign of Aarhus University and Universitas Diponegoro and shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years. If the MOU remains dormant for the full year, it will be deemed to have lapsed. Dormant MOUs can only be renewed subject to reaching agreement on the detailed nature of cooperation as described in 4.3.
- 3.2. The MOU may be renegotiated at any time during the period of the arrangement.

3.3. Any changes to the MOU must be documented with copies of the changes provided to both parties.

4. Agreement between parties

- 4.1. Nothing in this MOU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the parties; its provisions do not create rights, obligations or duties for either party. This MOU is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial co-operation.
- 4.2. This MOU shall not prejudice any rights and obligations of either Party in any international agreements or conventions.
- 4.3. If the parties do determine that they will enter into a specific project or agreement together, these will be the subject of contractual arrangements to be determined, and agreed between them with each project or agreement forming a "Schedule" attached to this MOU.
- 4.4. Aarhus University and Universitas Diponegoro acknowledge that in the absence of any specific agreement to the contrary, all expenses of salary, travel, living and allied costs will be determined at the discretion of and be the responsibility of the visitor's home University.
- 4.5. The University representatives responsible for this MOU are Prof. Lic. Scient. Brian Bech Nielsen, Rector of Aarhus University, and Prof. Dr. Yos Johan Utama, Rector of Universitas Diponegoro Details of the Partnership Leads are outlined in attachment 1 to this MOU.
